I. INTRODUCTION

1. On 16 July 2026, Pre-Trial Chamber I issued its “Decision on the confirmation of charges against Mr Khaled Mohamed Ali El Hishri” (“Pre-Trial Chamber’s Decision”), in which it ordered the Registrar to transmit the Decision and the record of the proceedings to the Presidency.¹
2. On 17 July 2026, pursuant to the Pre-Trial Chamber’s Decision, and in accordance with rule 129 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Registry transmitted the record of the proceedings to the Presidency.²
3. On 20 July 2026, the Presidency issued its “Decision constituting Trial Chamber VII and referring to it the case of *The Prosecutor v. Khaled Mohamed Ali El Hishri*” (“Presidency’s Decision”), in which it ordered the Registrar to transmit the full record of the proceedings to Trial Chamber VII (“Trial Chamber”), including the Pre-Trial Chamber’s Decision.³
4. On 22 July 2026, the Judges of the Trial Chamber elected Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor as Presiding Judge and as the Single Judge for the preparation of the trial.⁴
