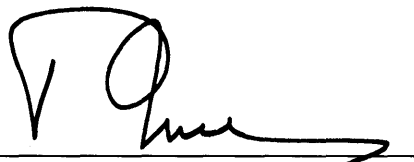

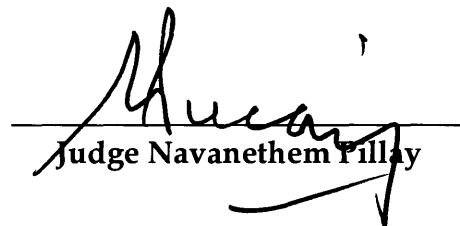
SCHEDULING ORDER
