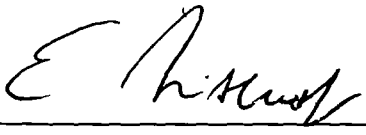

Potentially Exculpatory Evidence pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute
on 5 July 2006**

1. In compliance with the Decisions of the Single Judge of the Pre-Trial Chamber of 15 May 2006¹ and of 24 May 2006,² and following the disclosure of potentially exculpatory evidence on 5 July 2006, the Prosecution herewith files the "Disclosure Note".³
2. The "Disclosure Note" includes the "List of disclosed materials" detailing the items that fall under Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute and that have been disclosed to the Defence on 5 July 2006. The "Disclosure Note" is signed by both Parties.
3. In this particular instance, twenty-two out of twenty-nine documents included in the "List of disclosed materials" are handwritten documents, namely document numbers 3 to 24. In addition to the electronic copies, the Prosecution has also provided the Defence with paper copies of those twenty-two handwritten documents.
