1. In compliance with the Decisions of the Single Judge of the Pre-Trial Chamber of 15 May 2006¹ and of 24 May 2006,² the Prosecution herewith submits thirty-six items that on 23 August 2006 have been disclosed to the Defence pursuant to Article 61(3)(b) of the Rome Statute. In addition, the Prosecution submits a CD containing the electronic versions of these items.

2. Amongst the items set out in the "List of disclosed materials"³, the Prosecution submits the originals of the documents identified as numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 14, 25, 26 and 36.⁴

3. The Prosecution collected the materials detailed in the "List of disclosed materials" under numbers 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34 in electronic format. Therefore, in respect of these materials, the Prosecution is not in a position to submit their originals. Electronic versions of these materials are included in the CD containing the electronic version of all disclosed materials.

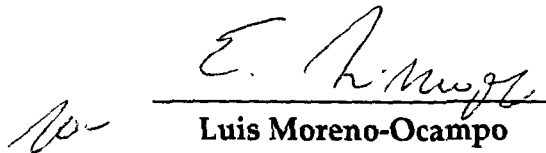

⁴ The document under number 1 is a notebook, and the cover of the notebook has a separate registration number (DRC-OTP-0017-0002) apparently due to a mistake during the actual registration process. This cover does not include any information. Although the registration number of this cover is not included in the list of disclosed material presented to the Defence on 23 August 2006, the Prosecution herewith files the original of the whole notebook under number 1 including the cover. The document under number 35 of the "List of disclosed materials" forms part of a document with the registration number DRC-OTP-0154-0533 that has already been disclosed to the Defence on 10 August 2006. The Prosecution has already submitted the original of the document (DRC-OTP-0154-0533) on 11 August 2006 that includes the original of the document under number 35.

4. The Prosecution has disclosed the documents under number 5, 11, 13, 15, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 30, 31, 33 and 34 of the "List of disclosed materials" with redactions.
5. The documents under numbers 1, 7, 8, 9 and 11 of the "List of disclosed materials" are handwritten documents. In addition to the electronic copies, the Prosecution has also provided the Defence with paper-copies of the documents.
