The Office of the Prosecutor respectfully submits the following response to the Single Judge's "Decision concerning Supporting Material in relation with the Prosecution's Application for Warrants of Arrest under Article 58 of the Statute", dated 26 June 2007.¹

Request for sealing

The Prosecution requests, in light of the sealed nature of yesterday's decision, that: (1) this application be received by the Pre-Trial Chamber under seal, (2) the fact of the existence of this application also be sealed.

Identifying Information Relating to Germain KATANGA and Mathieu NGUDJOLO CHUI

1. The Prosecution furnishes the following identifying information in relation to Germain KATANGA (also known as Simba). The best available information is that Germain KATANGA was born in Mambasa, Mambasa Territory, Ituri District, on the 28 April 1978. KATANGA is the son of Jacob NDURU and Elisabeth REGINE. KATANGA is married to Denise KATANGA and is the father of two children.

2. Mathieu NGUDJOLO CHUI was born in Bunia, Ituri District, on 8 October 1970, and is an *originaire* of Likoni village of Ezekere *groupement*. His father's name is believed to be Mawa LIKONI and his mother is named Lasi. NGUDJOLO is married to Semaka LEMI and is the father of two children.²

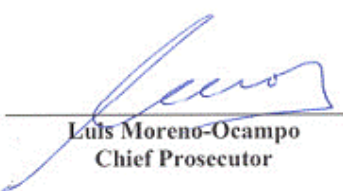
Invitation to submit the statements and additional supporting materials

3. At this stage in the proceedings, the OTP normally submits a "summary of the evidence and information" and would provide evidence, including witness

This evidence and information, which is responsive to both requests of the Single Judge, constitutes a part of the evidence and information currently in the OTP's possession and summarized in the application submitted under Art. 58.
