**Prosecution's communication of originals of incriminatory evidence disclosed
to the Defence on 30 November 2007**

1. The Prosecution herewith submits electronic versions of the 88 items disclosed to the Defence as incriminating evidence on 30 November 2007. In addition, the Prosecution provided to the Defence an update on the “ICC Element of Statement of Facts” field for 82 items that had previously been disclosed as incriminating evidence.

2. In compliance with the Trial Chamber’s 9 November 2007 “Decision Regarding the Timing and Manner of Disclosure and the Date of Trial” (“Trial Chamber’s Decision”),¹ the Prosecution also submits the evidence in its original form.

3. The items disclosed to the Defence on 30 November 2007 are listed in the annexed “List of disclosed materials”.² The Prosecution draws the Chamber’s attention to the fact that these items include further evidentiary materials that would support the view that the armed conflict in Ituri during the portions of the period relevant to the Document containing the charges was of an international character.³ The Prosecution

In light of the fact that the Document containing the charges made no reference to an armed conflict of an international character, the Prosecution has linked these documents to

emphasizes that the disclosure of these documents does not have a bearing on the position it took in its 12 September and 20 November 2007 submissions on the characterisation of the armed conflict.⁴

4. The Prosecution informs the Trial Chamber that 32 items were collected in electronic format. Thus, the Prosecution is not in possession of physical originals of the materials⁵. For these materials, the Prosecution instead files the original CDs which contained these documents at the time of registration.

5. In addition, the Prosecution informs the Trial Chamber that one document and one video tape disclosed to the Defence contain redactions that are

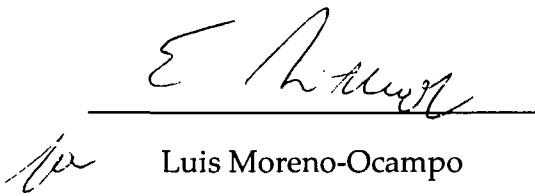

6. The Prosecution has not submitted these two items in their original form. The Prosecution will address the issue of submission of originals of redacted materials with the Trial Chamber in a separate filing.
