SUBMITS the following notice to both the Office of The Prosecutor and the Defence:

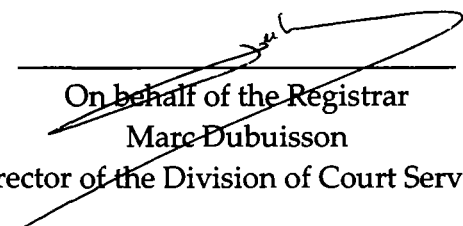
