**REQUEST TO THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA FOR THE ARREST AND
SURRENDER OF BOSCO NTAGANDA**

THE REGISTRAR of the International Criminal Court,

NOTING the warrant of arrest issued for Mr Bosco Ntaganda on 7 March 2007 by Pre-Trial Chamber I ("the Chamber") pursuant to article 58 of the *Statute of the Court* ("the Statute"), to which photographs of Mr Ntaganda are attached;¹

NOTING the decision of the Chamber issued on 6 March 2007, assigning to the Registrar of the Court the task of preparing and transmitting the request for the arrest and surrender of Mr Bosco Ntaganda to the competent authorities of the Republic of Uganda, in accordance with rule 176 of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence*;²

NOTING articles 19, 20, 57, 59, 60, 67, 87, 89, 91 and 97 of the Statute, rules 21, 117 to 119, 176, 184 and 187 of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence* and regulations 31, 76 and 111 of the *Regulations of the Court*;

CONSIDERING that, pursuant to article 89(1) of the Statute, the Court may transmit a request for the arrest and surrender of a person to any State on the territory of which that person may be found;

REQUESTS the Republic of Uganda ("the requested State") to execute the warrant of arrest issued by Pre-Trial Chamber I for Bosco Ntaganda, alleged to be around thirty-five years of age; alleged to have been the former Deputy Chief of General Staff for Military Operations of the FPLC prior to 8 December 2003; allegedly appointed Chief of Staff of the FPLC on 8 December 2003; alleged to be currently one of the commanders of the *Mouvement Révolutionnaire du Congo* [Congolese Revolutionary Movement] (MRC), a militia group which has been operating in and around the District of Ituri since the beginning of 2005; and who is also known as Bosco Tanganda, Bosco Ntanganda, Bosco Ntangana, Bosco Ntagenda, Bosco Baganda, Bosco Taganda and "the Terminator";

REQUESTS the requested State to ensure the safety of Bosco Ntaganda until his final surrender to the Registrar of the Court;

REQUESTS, pursuant to article 87(3) of the Statute, the requested State to keep confidential this request for arrest and surrender and any documents attached thereto, except to the extent that their disclosure is necessary for the execution of this request;

REQUESTS, pursuant to article 87(4) of the Statute, the requested State to provide and handle any information that is made available to it with respect to this request in a manner that protects the safety and physical or psychological well-being of any victims, potential witnesses and their families;

REQUESTS the requested State to inform the Court of any application made by Bosco Ntaganda to a national court under articles 59(3) or 89(2) of the Statute;

REQUESTS the requested State to notify the Court, pursuant to article 91(2)(c) of the Statute, of any documents, statements or information, other than the warrant of arrest and the photographs attached thereto, as may be necessary for the requested State to meet the requirements for the surrender process;

REQUESTS the requested State to inform the Court, pursuant to article 97 of the Statute, of any problems which may impede or prevent the execution of this request or which may delay it as contemplated under article 89(4) of the Statute;

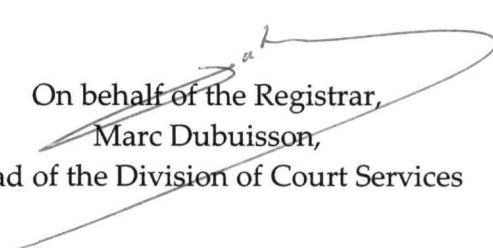
REQUESTS that the requested State deliver Bosco Ntaganda to the Court as soon as possible once it has ordered his surrender;

REQUESTS the requested State to immediately inform the Registrar of the Court, pursuant to rule 184 of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence*, when Bosco Ntaganda is available for surrender to the Court;

REMINDS the requested State of its obligation to comply with the procedure set forth in article 59 of the Statute;

ATTACHES to this request, in accordance with articles 87 and 91 of the Statute, rule 187 of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence* and regulation 111 of the *Regulations of the Court*, the following documents:

- i) a copy of the warrant of arrest, in English for the requested State and in French and Swahili for Bosco Ntaganda, issued on 7 March 2007, to which his photographs are attached;
- ii) an English copy of the decision on the admissibility of the case concerning Bosco Ntaganda, submitted by Pre-Trial Chamber I on 6 March 2007;
- iii) as well as a copy of the relevant provisions of the Statute and the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence* in a language which Bosco Ntaganda fully understands and speaks.
