NOTING the “Decision Convening a Hearing on 18 February 2008”¹ and the *ex parte* hearing held on 18 February 2008 with the Prosecution and the representatives of the Registry;

NOTING the Single Judge’s “Decision to unseal and reclassify certain documents in the record of the case against Germain Katanga” of 20 February 2008²;

NOTING Rule 18(a) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulations 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge decided that “the Registrar shall file by Monday 25 February 2008 a public note explaining the general nature” of *inter alia* document ICC-01/04-01/07-138-Conf-Exp³;

CONSIDERING that this document was classified confidential *ex parte* only available to the Prosecution as it includes detailed information on different protection measures requested by the Prosecution;

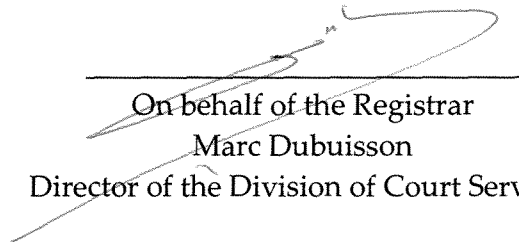
