THE REGISTRAR of the International Criminal Court ("the Court");

NOTING the "*Mandat d'arrêt à l'encontre de Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo remplaçant le mandat d'arrêt décerné le 23 mai 2008*"¹ ("the Warrant of arrest of 10 June") issued by the Pre-Trial Chamber III ("the Chamber") on 10 June 2008 ;

NOTING the "*Application for interim release*"² submitted by the Defence on 23 July 2008;

NOTING the "*Decision Requesting Observations on the Defence's Application for Interim Release*"³ ("Decision of 4 August") issued by the Chamber on 4 August 2008;

NOTING articles 60(2) and 87 of the *Rome Statute* ("the Statute"); rules 118, 119 and 176(2) of the *Rules of Procedure and Evidence* ("the Rules"); regulations 23bis, 24bis, 34 and 51 of the *Regulations of the Court* ("the Regulations");

CONSIDERING that the Chamber requested the relevant authorities of the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Portugal, the Swiss Confederation and the Kingdom of the Netherlands to submit observations by no later than 14 August 2008 on:

- "(i) the application for interim release and
- (ii) the conditions, if any, that would have to be met in order for the State to accept Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba's release on its territory"⁴;

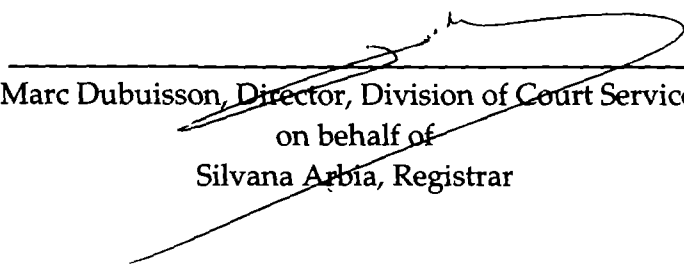

CONSIDERING that, on 5 August 2008, the Registry notified a note verbale requesting the cooperation of the competent authorities of the above-mentioned States as well as the Decision of 4 August 2008, the Warrant of arrest of 10 June 2008 and the Application for interim release (Annex 1, attached hereto);

CONSIDERING that, despite several reminders, the Swiss authorities did not return a signed copy of the Memorandum of Service confirming good reception of the documents; and that they submitted their observations in the format of an email;

TRANSMITS, respectfully and in accordance with rule 176(2) of the Rules, the observations of the Kingdom of Belgium (Annex 2, attached hereto), of the Republic of Portugal (Annex 3, attached hereto), of the Swiss Confederation (Annex 4, attached hereto) and of the Kingdom of the Netherlands (Annex 5, attached hereto);
