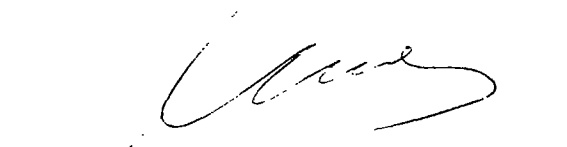

In compliance with the oral order of Pre-Trial Chamber III (the Chamber) at the status conference held on 22 October 2008, the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits, in appended annexes to this submission, consolidated versions of in-depth analysis charts for all items of evidence disclosed to the Defence as incriminating and potentially exonerating evidence and materials submitted for inspection pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹

Request for the Receipt of Annex A as Under Seal, *Ex parte*, Prosecution Only and Annexes B, C and D as Confidential-Prosecution and Defence Only

The Prosecution requests that Annex A² appended to this document, be received by the Chamber as "Under Seal, *ex parte* – Prosecution Only" as this annex contains information on all witnesses, including those granted protection by the Chamber.³ The Prosecution requests that Annexes B,⁴ C⁵ and D⁶ be received by the Chamber as confidential—Prosecution and Defence Only, because they contain information on witnesses known to the Defence and not to the public.⁷
