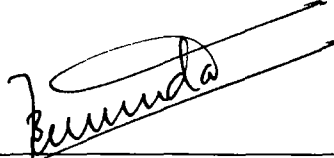

I. Introduction

In compliance with the orders of Pre-Trial Chamber III (hereinafter referred to as “the Chamber”) contained in the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties¹, the Office of the Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as “the Prosecution”) herewith submits the report for 13 items of recently registered material disclosed to the Defence team of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo as incriminating evidence (items to be included in the Prosecution’s Second Amended List of Evidence) on 5 November 2008.²
