I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") communicates to the Defence, in appended annexes to this document, the amended Document Containing the Charges against Jean-Pierre BEMBA GOMBO ("Amended DCC") and the amended List of Evidence ("Amended List of Evidence") in versions implementing the Third Decision on the Prosecutor's Requests for Redactions and Related Request for the Regulation of Contacts of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo¹. This Amended DCC and the Amended List of Evidence, on which the Prosecution intends to rely at the Confirmation Hearing scheduled to commence on 8 December 2008², are submitted pursuant to Articles 61 (3) and (4) of the Rome Statute (the "Statute") as well as Rule 121 (4) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") and Regulation 52 of the Regulations of the Court³.

II. Request for the Receipt of Annexes as Confidential – Prosecution and Defence Only

2. The Prosecution requests that Annexes, appended to this document, be received by the Chamber as "Confidential – Prosecution and Defence Only" as they contain identifying information of witnesses who are known to the Defence but not to the public. These requests are made to protect victims and witnesses pursuant to Article 68(1) of the Statute and Rule 81(4) of the Rules.
