I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") communicates to the Defence, in appended Annex A to this document, a list of the names and corresponding codes of Prosecution's witnesses, implementing the Third Decision on the Prosecutor's Requests for Redactions and Related Request for the Regulation of Contacts of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo¹. The Prosecution respectfully submits that it intends to refer to witnesses exclusively by their assigned codes at the Confirmation Hearing scheduled to commence on 8 December 2008².

II. Request for confidentiality

2. The Prosecution requests that Annex A, appended to this document, be received by the Chamber as "Confidential – Prosecution and Defence Only" as they contain identifying information of witnesses who are known to the Defence but not to the public. These requests are made to protect victims and witnesses pursuant to Article 68(1) of the Rome Statute and Rule 81(4) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
