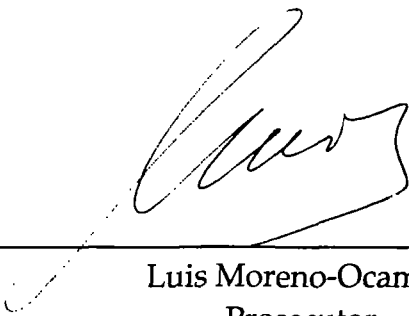

² On 13 May 2005, the Prosecution filed its "Prosecution information on incriminating evidence that is unlikely to be relied on at trial and on two expert witnesses on age determination which the Prosecution will not call", ICC-01/04-01/06-1323-CONF with Confidential, Prosecution and Defence Only, Annex. In this filing, the Prosecution advised of certain documents that, in principle, it does not intend to rely upon at trial. The Prosecution noted that it would inform the Chamber and the Defence should it decide that it is necessary to rely on any of these items. The Prosecution has included 37 of these items in the attached annexes. They are identified as items #929-965 in Annex 2. The Prosecution will inform the Chamber and the Defence of any additional items, as necessary.
