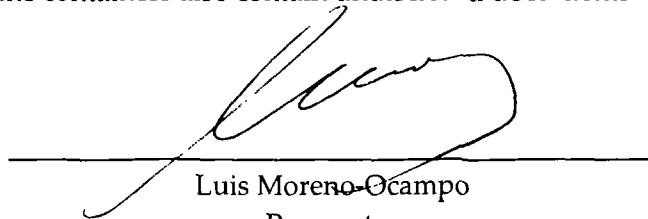

Submission of originals of incriminatory evidence

1. The Prosecution informs the Trial Chamber that it disclosed to the Defence 13 items of incriminating evidence on 30 January 2009. These 13 items are listed in the attached "List of Disclosed Materials".¹
2. 12 of these items are the French/Swahili or French/Lingala translations of previously disclosed witness statements which will be included in the witness familiarisation packages. One item is a map of Ituri which the Prosecution may use during the examination of witness WWWW-0299.²
3. The Prosecution herewith submits original versions of 3 items.³

Item for which no physical original is being filed

4. The Prosecution informs the Trial Chamber that 4 items have been disclosed to the Defence in redacted form.⁴ In light of these redactions⁵, the originals of these items have not been filed with the Registry.
5. The remaining 6 items are electronic documents which will not be provided to the Registry as the containers also contain undisclosed documents.⁶
