1. **Trial Chamber II** of the International Criminal Court (respectively, “the Chamber” and “the Court”) is seized of an application (“the Application”),¹ filed on 9 February 2009 by Germain Katanga’s Defence, for an extension of the page limit of a document which it wishes to file under article 19(2) of the Rome Statute (“the Statute”). It asks that the number of pages authorised under regulation 37(1) of the *Regulations of the Court* be increased from 20 to 45.

2. The Chamber reminds Germain Katanga’s Defence that, under the terms of regulation 38(1)(c) of the *Regulations of the Court*, which specifies the permitted number of pages for certain types of documents filed by the parties, the page limit for challenges to admissibility or jurisdiction pursuant to article 19(2) of the Statute cannot exceed one hundred. It is therefore unnecessary to rule on the Application.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER:

1. **FINDS IT UNNECESSARY TO RULE** on the Application;
2. **REMINDS** the participants in the proceedings that, pursuant to regulation 34 of the *Regulations of the Court*, they have 21 days from the date of notification of any application filed under article 19(2) of the Statute in which to file a response; and
3. **AUTHORIZES** Germain Katanga’s Defence, if it considers it necessary, to file a reply pursuant to regulations 24 and 34 of the *Regulations of the Court* to the above-mentioned responses within 10 days from notification of the last response registered.
