I, Judge Cuno Tarfusser, Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of Pre-Trial Chamber I in relation to the proceedings of the situation in Darfur, Sudan and any related cases emanating therefrom, including the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bahar Idriss Abu Garda* (the “Case”), at the International Criminal Court¹;

NOTING the “Application for extension of time and to request filing of further evidence into the record of the Case” and the Annex attached thereto, dated 6 October 2009, whereby the Defence requested the Single Judge to extend the deadline for filing evidence into the record of the Case, in order for it to be allowed to file one item of evidence into such a record;

CONSIDERING that the reasons provided by the Defence in the Confidential Annex to its Application appear to fall outside its control, therefore justifying a request for extension of time after the lapse of time-limit pursuant to regulation 35(2) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING, furthermore, that the piece of evidence which the Defence intends to file into the records of the Case was disclosed to it by the Prosecutor as potentially exculpatory evidence and, therefore, that granting the Defence’s request would not result in any prejudice to the Prosecutor;

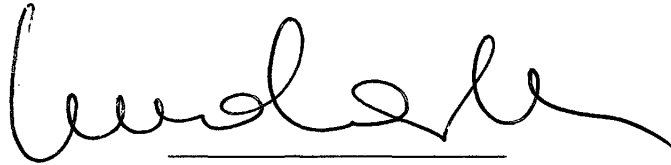
FOR THESE REASONS**DECIDE**
