NOTING Trial Chamber I's *Decision on the application by 7 victims to participate in the proceedings* of 10 July 2009¹ and its annex², in which the Chamber, *inter alia*:

- i. Rejected the application of victim a/0609/08 to participate in the proceedings and instructed the Registry to contact the applicant and his legal representative to seek clarification or further information on the application ;³ and
