On 14 July 2009, at the hearing of the testimony of the witness DRC-OTP-WWWW-0046, the Trial Chamber (“Chamber”), pursuant to submissions from the Defence¹, asked the United Nations representative (Larry Johnson) to obtain from the United Nations a list² of all staff members at the professional level who worked in the MONUC’s Child Protection Unit.³
