NOTING the “Prosecution’s Application for Admission of Documents from the Bar Table Pursuant to Article 64(9)” (the “Application”) filed on 17 February 2009¹;

NOTING the “Decision on the admission of material from the “bar table”” (the “Decision”) issued by Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”) on 24 June 2009²;

NOTING the “Submission by the Registry of the EVD numbers assigned to the material from the “bar table” having satisfied the test for admissibility” and its annex³ filed on 17 July 2009;

NOTING regulation 27 of the Regulations of the Registry;

CONSIDERING that in its Application the Prosecution sought the admission of various documents into evidence “from the bar table;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber listed in a table annexed to its Decision the material which satisfies the admissibility test;

CONSIDERING that during the hearing held on 13 July 2009 the Presiding Judge ordered that the documents from the bar table which do not already have an EVD number assigned either at the Pre-Trial or Trial stage, be assigned such a number⁴;

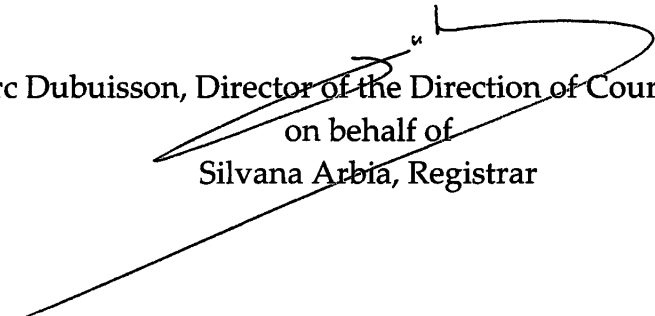
