1. On 25 February 2010, the Defence submitted its Request challenging the admissibility of the case pursuant to Articles 17 and 19(2)(a) of the Rome Statute (“Defence Request”).¹
2. At the status conference on 8 March 2010, Trial Chamber III ordered that the Legal Representative file observations on the Defence Request by 29 March 2010.²
3. On 23 March 2010, the Legal Representative filed an application for an extension of time for the submission of her observations to 1 April 2010.
4. The Office of the Prosecutor does not oppose the application.
