THE REGISTRAR of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the “*Decision on the admission into evidence of materials contained in the prosecution’s list of evidence*” issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”) on 19 November 2010 (the “Decision”);¹

NOTING the “*Prosecution’s Submission of Updated List of Evidence and Other Information*” submitted with confidential annexes A and B by the Prosecution on 22 November 2010 (the “Prosecution’s Application”);²

NOTING article 64(9)(a) and (10) of the Rome Statute; rules 15; 63(2) and 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence; regulations 28 and 53 of the Regulations of the Registry;

CONSIDERING that the Majority of the Chamber in its Decision ordered the Registry to “to assign EVD-T number to each item” once the revised List of Evidence is filed;

CONSIDERING that, during the open session of the hearing of 23 November 2010, the Chamber ordered the Registry “not to assign an EVD-T number to the materials included as numbers 4, 5, 6 and 7” of the Prosecution’s updated list of evidence;³

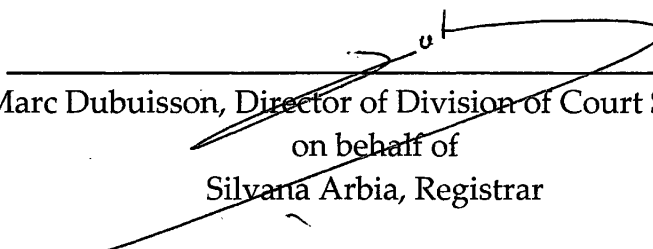
