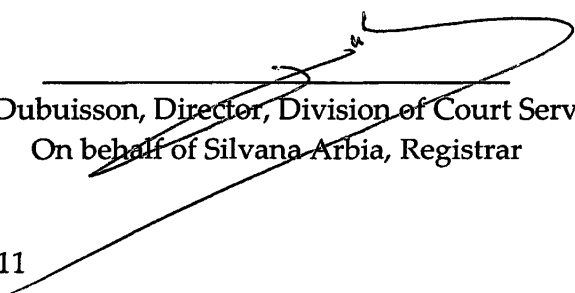
NOTING Rule 94(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

NOTING Trial Chamber III’s oral decision of 22 November 2010 requesting the Registry to provide notification of any request for reparations received so far to Mr Bemba’s defence team as soon as practicable;¹

CONSIDERING that the Registry has received 332 applications for reparations that contain the information enumerated in Rule 94(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has redacted the applications for reparations in accordance with the guidelines on redactions for applications for participation provided in the 22 February 2010 Decision;²

TRANSMITS 332 applications for reparations in redacted form to the Defence of Mr Jean Pierre Bemba³.
