I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”), herewith submits the pre-inspection report regarding five documents disclosed to the Defence team of Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo (“Defence”) on 21 January 2011 pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting and Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.¹

2. These five documents were not previously disclosed, as any information alluded to therein, is contained in further detail in the statements of Witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0068. However, upon Defence request,² the Prosecution disclosed them so as to facilitate the Defence examination of the above-mentioned witness.
