Submission

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits the updated *curriculum vitae* ("CV") of expert witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0229 ("Witness 229"). The Prosecution recalls that on 7 October 2010, Trial Chamber III ("Chamber") approved Witness 229's instruction as an expert witness on sexual violence as a tool of war.¹

2. Prior to the Chamber's approval and the expert's inclusion on the Court's List of Experts, the Prosecution had provided the Chamber and the participants with the expert's CV reflecting his qualifications as of September 2010.² In preparing for his testimony scheduled for March 2011, Witness 229 provided the Prosecution with a more detailed CV that also reflects an additional qualification acquired in November 2010. The Prosecution submits the updated version as Annex A to facilitate the examination of the expert witness.

3. The Prosecution requests that Annex A appended to this submission be received by the Chamber as "Confidential" as it relates to information that is not known to the public.
