Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits the signed letter of receipt regarding one document disclosed to the Defence team of Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo (“Defence”) on 17 February 2011 pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹ This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.²

2. This document was not previously disclosed, as it contains neither incriminatory nor potentially exculpatory evidence and it did not appear to be material to the preparation of the defence. However, upon Defence request,³ the Prosecution disclosed it so as to facilitate the Defence examination of Witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0042.
