CONSIDERING that the Chamber in its Decision instructed the Registry to assign EVD numbers to the statements (as annexed to the Prosecution’s application);

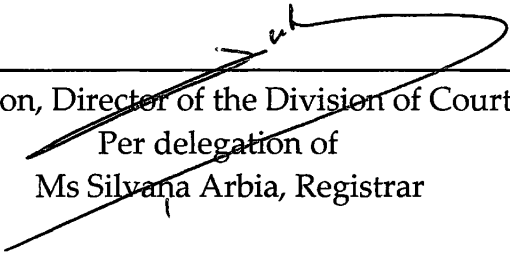
