Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits the pre-inspection report regarding three documents disclosed to the Defence team of Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo (“Defence”) on 8 March 2011 pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. This communication is submitted in accordance with the operative disclosure regime, the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties.¹

2. The three documents in question were received by the Prosecution after the expiry of the time limit imposed by Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) to file the report of Witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0229. The documents were not previously disclosed, as any information alluded to therein was also contained in the report itself. The Prosecution then disclosed the documents at the request of the Defence.²

3. The Prosecution requests that Annex A appended to this communication be received by the Chamber as “Confidential”, as it contains information related to an expert witness’ report, which has been treated as confidential by the Chamber.
