NOTING Trial Chamber I’s Decision of 14 October 2010 in which Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”) ordered the VPRS “to provide the information from the application forms of victims a/0225/06, a/0229/06 and a/0270/07 to the defence and the prosecution in accordance with the details of this Decision (...)” (the “Decision”);¹

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTING regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court, the annexes to the present documents are classified as “Confidential” considering that the information contained in the annexes relates to the identities and identifying elements of persons mentioned in the application forms;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has removed from the application forms the redactions in accordance with the details of the Decision;

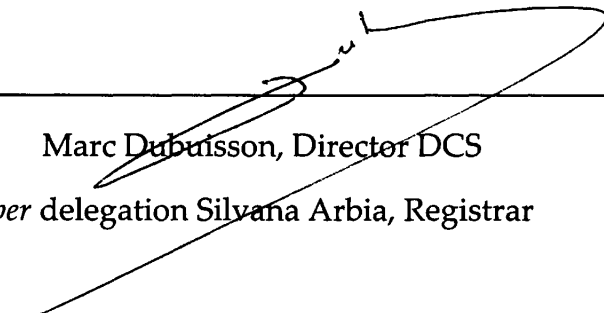
CONSIDERING that since the Registry has not yet been able to contact one person mentioned in the applications of victims a/0229/06 and a/0270/07 to obtain his views as regards informing the defence of his identity as requested by the Chamber in the Decision,² or three other persons as requested by the Chamber subsequently, their identities remain redacted in the said applications for the time being until otherwise instructed by the Chamber;³
