I. Background

1. During the Status Conference on 19 April 2011, Trial Chamber IV ("Trial Chamber") ordered "the Prosecution together with the legal representatives to file a report indicating in a table the victims' applications, numbers of the dual status individuals, the corresponding witness codes and which of the legal representatives are representing these individuals -- these dual status victims".¹ The Chamber further ordered that these joint submissions be filed by 9 May 2011.²

2. Pursuant to the Trial Chamber's order, the Prosecution and the Legal Representatives concerned hereby submit, in a Joint Filing, a table containing the seven dual status victims, together with their respective Legal Representatives.

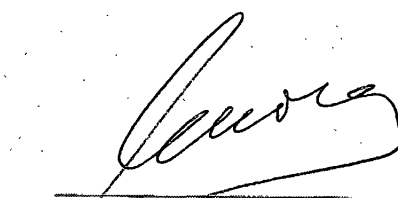
