NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 (4), (5) and (7) of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTING the “Decision defining the status of 54 victims who participated at the pre-trial stage, and inviting the parties’ observations on applications for participation by 86 applicants” issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”), dated 22 February 2010 (“22 February 2010 Decision”);¹

NOTING the “Decision on the participation of victims in the trial and on 86 applications by victims to participate in the proceedings” dated 12 July 2010;²

NOTING the “Decision on 772 applications by victims to participate in the proceedings” dated 18 November 2010;³

NOTING the “Decision on 653 applications by victims to participate in the proceedings” dated 23 December 2010;⁴

NOTING the order of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 16 September 2010, that applications for participation in the proceedings received by the Registry be transmitted to the parties in redacted form on an ongoing basis as and when they are prepared, and in accordance with the guidelines on redactions provided in the 22 February 2010 Decision;⁵

NOTING the order of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 26 August 2010 that in relation to all future applications the Registry should systematically notify

the respective legal representatives of the applicants of the redacted versions of applications as notified to the parties;⁶

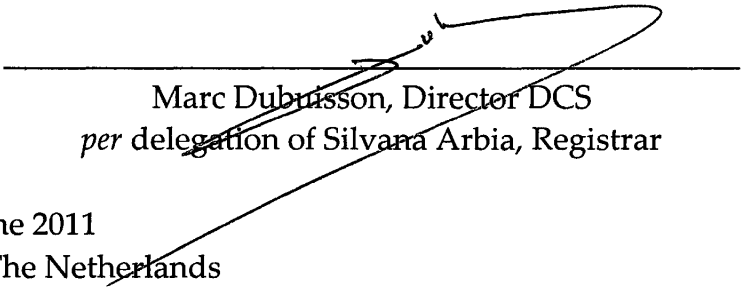
NOTING paragraph 8 of the “Decision setting a time-limit for the submission of new victims’ applications for participation” dated 7 September 2010;⁷

NOTING the instruction of the Chamber of 7 June 2011 ordering that during the week of 20 June 2011 the Registry file certain applications for participation in the present case which were referred to in the Registry’s confidential report⁸ of 3 June 2011;⁹

CONSIDERING that the Registry has transmitted a total of 203 applications to the Chamber;¹⁰

CONSIDERING that 104 of these applications for participation have already been transmitted to the Chamber, the parties and the participants but have since been supplemented with further information as explained in the Registry’s confidential report¹¹ of 3 June 2011;¹²

TRANSMITS the 203 applications to participate in the proceedings to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants in redacted version.
