PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER I ("Chamber") of the International Criminal Court ("Court");

NOTING the "Prosecutor's Application Pursuant to Article 58 as to Muammar Mohammed Abu Minyar GADDAFI, Saif Al-Islam GADDAFI and Abdullah AL-SENUSSI" ("Prosecutor's Application")¹ filed by the Prosecutor on 16 May 2011, and by which he requested the issuance of warrants of arrest for Muammar Gaddafi, Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi, and Abdullah Al-Senussi, for their alleged criminal responsibility for the commission of murder and persecution of civilians as crimes against humanity from 15 February 2011 onwards throughout Libya in, *inter alia*, Tripoli, Benghazi, and Misrata, through the Libyan State apparatus and Security Forces, in violation of article 7(1)(a) and (h) of the Rome Statute ("Statute") and as principals to these crimes in accordance with article 25(3)(a) of the Statute;

HAVING examined the information and evidence provided by the Prosecutor in his Application in light of the standard set out in article 58 of the Statute to determine whether there are reasonable grounds to believe that Muammar Mohammed Abu Minyar Gaddafi, Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi and Abdullah Al-Senussi have committed the crimes alleged by the Prosecutor, and whether their arrest appears necessary;

NOTING article 58 of the Statute and Regulation 20 of the Regulations of the Court;

HEREBY SCHEDULES a hearing to be held in a public session on Monday 27 June 2011 at 13.00 pm, for the purposes of delivering its Decision on the Prosecutor's Application, and allows the Office of the Prosecutor to send up to two representatives.

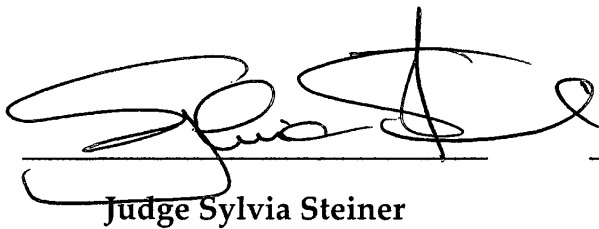

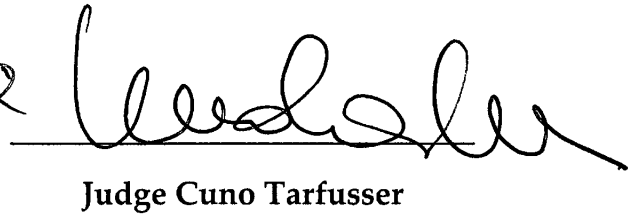
