The Registrar of the International Criminal Court ("the Court");

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulation 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTING the Decision on the Prosecutor's Application for Summons to Appear for William Samoei Ruto, Henry Kiprono Kosgey and Joshua Arap Sang;¹

NOTING the Decision Designating a Single Judge;²

NOTING the First Decision on Victims' Participation in the Case (the "First Decision");³

NOTING the Decision on the Registrar's "Request for instructions on the processing of victims' applications" in which the Registry was instructed to transmit only complete applications to the Chamber;⁴

NOTING the instructions of the Chamber that applications transmitted to it in unredacted form should nonetheless indicate the redactions which have been applied to the versions transmitted to the parties and participants;⁵

NOTING the Registry's Third transmission to the Pre-Trial Chamber of applications to participate in the proceedings;⁶

CONSIDERING that on 8 July the Registry transmitted 230 applications for participation to the Chamber⁷ and that on 11 July redacted versions of the 230

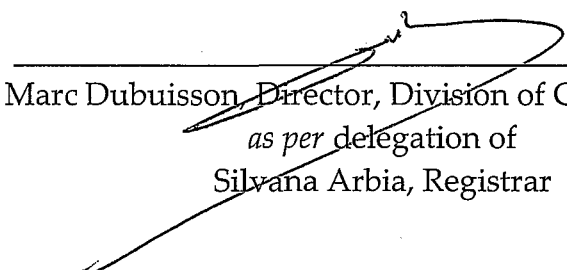
applications were transmitted to the parties and the legal representatives of the respective applicants;⁸

CONSIDERING that eight⁹ of the 230 applications contained portions in Kiswahili, of which translations were not able to be made before the 8 July deadline;

CONSIDERING that translations of this material have now been completed;

CONSIDERING that the applications annexed to the present report contain information which may serve to identify the applicants and for which are classified by the Registry as confidential *ex parte*;

TRANSMITS to the Chamber consolidated versions of the eight applications for participation.
