NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and regulation 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTING the Decision on the Prosecutor’s Application for Summons to Appear for William Samoei Ruto, Henry Kiprono Kosgey and Joshua Arap Sang;¹

NOTING the Decision Designating a Single Judge;²

NOTING the First Decision on Victims’ Participation in the Case (the “First Decision”);³

NOTING the Decision on the Registrar’s “Request for instructions on the processing of victims’ applications” in which the Registry was instructed to transmit only complete applications to the Chamber;⁴

NOTING the Registry’s Third transmission to the parties and legal representatives of redacted applications to participate in the proceedings;⁵

CONSIDERING that on 8 July the Registry transmitted 230 applications for participation to the Chamber⁶ and that on 11 July redacted versions of the 230 applications were transmitted to the parties and the legal representatives of the respective applicants;⁷

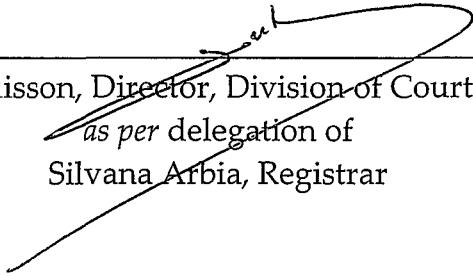
