**The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);**

**NOTING** the decision of Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”), dated 9 December 2009,<sup>1</sup> in which the Chamber decided that the Office of the Public Counsel for Victims shall represent those victim applicants who have not chosen a legal representative until a decision is made on their application to participate;

**NOTING** the decision of the Chamber, dated 19 November 2010,<sup>2</sup> recalling that applicants who have either not chosen a legal representative or mentioned in their applications their willingness to be represented by the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”), are represented by the OPCV until a decision is made on their applications to participate;

**NOTING** the Eleventh transmission to the Chamber of applications for participation in the proceedings<sup>3</sup> and the Eleventh transmission to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants of redacted versions of applications for participation in the proceedings, dated 15 July 2011;<sup>4</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the 98 applicants listed in annex 1 attached transmitted to the parties and the Chamber on 15 July 2011 do not have a legal representative or have expressed the willingness to be represented by the OPCV;

**NOTIFIES** the parties and participants that the Office of Public Counsel for Victims represents the applicants listed in annex 1 until a decision is made on

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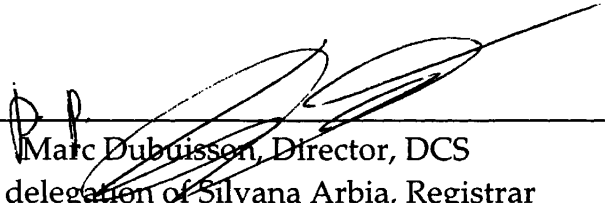
