NOTING the Proposal for the common legal representation of victims ("the Proposal");¹

NOTING rules 16(l)(b) and 90 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence; regulations 23bis, 79 , 80 and 86(8) of the Regulations of the Court; and regulations 112 and 113 of the Regulations of the Registry;

CONSIDERING that the present document is classified confidential *ex parte*, Registry only in order to preserve the anonymity of the candidates for common legal representatives proposed by the Registry so that the Chamber is in a position to freely decide on the current proposal without prejudicing the candidates' reputation;

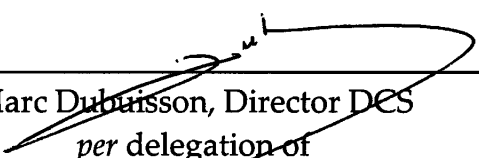
TRANSMITS to Trial Chamber IV (the "Chamber") an addendum to the Proposal for the common legal representation of victims as follows:

1. On 25 August 2011 the Registry filed to the Chamber its Proposal recommending to the Chamber that two counsel be appointed as, respectively, principal counsel and associate counsel to represent all participating victims in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Abdallah Abakaer Nourain and Saleh Mohammed Jerbo Jamus*.²
2. The current document is intended to provide additional information to the Chamber on the identity of the individuals the Registry recommends for each of the position, should the Chamber approve the Registry's proposal for the organisation of common legal representation of victims in the present case.

3. This recommendation is based on the result of the selection process which was described in paragraphs 16 and *seq.* of the Proposal, during which a panel considered thoroughly the strengths of the candidates against the criteria to select common legal representative(s).³
4. Based on the outcome of that process, the Registry recommends to the Chamber the following composition of the team:
 - i. Ms. Helen Cissé as principal counsel,
 - ii. Mr. Jens Dieckman as associate counsel.
