INTRODUCTION

1. On 20 April 2011, the Single Judge set the regime for disclosure in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Muthaura et al.* In accordance with rule 121(4) of the Rules of Evidence and Procedure, the Single Judge ordered that the Defence disclose any evidence in which it intends to rely upon for the purposes of the Confirmation of Charges hearing (the "Hearing") no later than fifteen days before the Hearing at 1600h.¹

REQUEST

2. The Defence for General Ali respectfully request a two hour extension for submitting its disclosure to the Prosecutor and Registry. The team received three pieces of evidence today from Kenya by way of the VWU at 1430h. The Defence feels that this evidence important in the Defence of General Ali.
