I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

1. On 7 April 2011, the Single Judge issued her “Decision Setting the Regime for Evidence Disclosure and Other Related Matters” (the “First Disclosure Decision”).¹
2. On 29 April 2011, the Single Judge issued her “Decision on the ‘Prosecutors application requesting disclosure after a final resolution of the Government’s Kenya’s admissibility challenge’ and Establishing a Calendar for Disclosure Between the Parties” (the “Second Disclosure Decision”).² In the Second Disclosure Decision the Single Judge ordered the Defence teams to disclose to the Prosecutor the evidence they intend to present at the confirmation hearing, if any, and to file the list of such evidence, no later than Monday 5 September 2011.³
3. On 5 September 2011, the Single Judge issued her “Decision on the Extension of Time Limit for Disclosure under Rule 121(6) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence” (the “Extension of Time Decision”), in which she granted the Defence team of Mr. Kenyatta until 23:59 hours on 5 September 2011 to complete the filing of its list of evidence, by amending the meta-data of the items which are object of the Decision on Reclassification.⁴

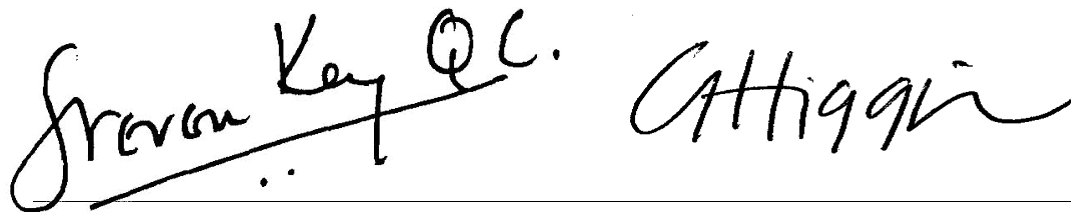
