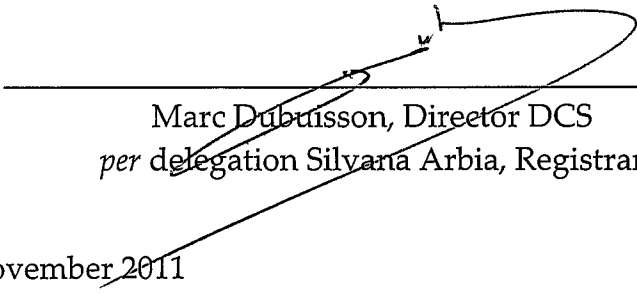

NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber II’s *“Decision on Victims’ Participation in Proceedings Related to the Situation in the Central African Republic”*¹ (hereinafter, “the Decision”) of 11 November 2011 ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (hereinafter, the “VPRS”) to report periodically every three months on the applications received in the situation in the Central African Republic and the progress made by the VPRS on their assessment under rule 85 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;
