1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith notifies the Trial Chamber III ("Chamber") that on 23 November 2011, it disclosed five documents as Rule 77 evidence that may be material to the preparation of the Defence team of Mr. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo. This disclosure took place in accordance the operative disclosure regime, the " Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure between the Parties".¹

2. Although the documents are related to Witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0069, they are not relied upon by the Prosecution. Nevertheless, the Prosecution disclosed these documents in order to facilitate the preparation of the Defence. The documents contain a total of 7 pages : sketches, the birth certificate of the witness² and a short summary of an initial pre-interview meeting between the witness and investigators of the Prosecution.
