The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (The "Court");

NOTING the Chamber's "Decision on 418 applications by victims to participate in the proceedings" dated 15 December 2011 ordering the Registry to provide the parties with a lesser redacted version of application a/0507/11 completed by the victim who also appeared as a witness before the Chamber ("Decision of 15 December");¹

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute and rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that application a/0507/11 was transmitted to the Chamber² in a non-redacted form and to the parties³ in a redacted form on 9 September 2011;

CONSIDERING that victim a/0507/11 was granted participating status by the Chamber in the Decision of 15 December and has also appeared as a witness before the Court;⁴

CONSIDERING that on 16 December 2011 the Chamber provided the Registry with a hard copy of the application of the said victim highlighting the redactions to be lifted and that the Registry has prepared a newly redacted version of the application in accordance with the Chamber's instructions;⁵

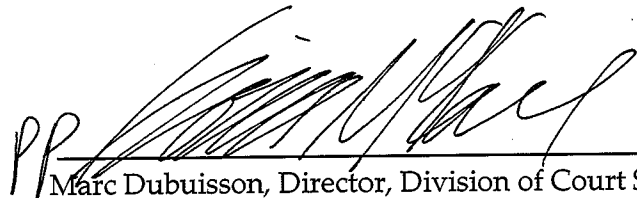
