Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) of the International Criminal Court in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* issues the following Order regarding the reclassification of documents.

1. On 28 December 2011, the defence filed its “Requête de Mise en liberté provisoire de M. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo” (“Application”). On the same day, the Chamber also issued a decision shortening the time to provide observations on the Application, while the Office of the Prosecutor filed observations on the Application on 30 December 2011. These documents bear the following court record numbers:
 - a. ICC-01/05-01/08-2029-Conf;¹
 - b. ICC-01/05-01/08-2030-Conf;² and
 - c. ICC-01/05-01/08-2031-Conf.³
2. On 6 January 2012, the Chamber ruled on the Application in its “Decision on the defence’s 28 December 2011 ‘Requête de Mise en liberté provisoire de M. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo’” (“Decision”).⁴ A public redacted version of the Decision was issued on 19 January 2012.⁵
3. In the Chamber’s view, certain information contained in the filings listed above in paragraph 1 no longer warrants confidential treatment. Thus, consistent with the principle of public proceedings enshrined in Articles 64(7) and 67(1) of the Rome Statute (“Statute”) and pursuant to Article

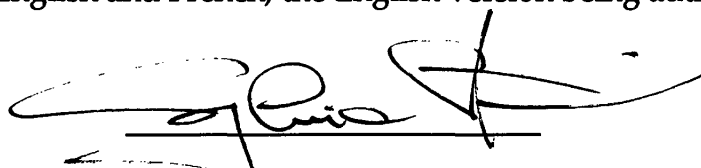

64(6)(f) of the Statute and Regulation 23*bis*(3) of the Regulations of the Court, the Chamber ORDERS that:

- a. The Registry shall reclassify document ICC-01/05-01/08-2030-Conf as public; and
- b. The parties shall, no later than 30 January 2012, (i) file public redacted versions of the documents listed above in paragraph 1(a) and (c); or (ii) inform the Chamber if they believe that the documents can be reclassified as public without redactions.
