TRANSMITS to the Presidency the following indexes:

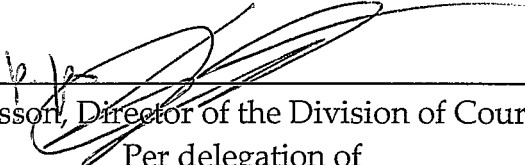
