NOTING the Order issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”) dated 6 March 2012, ordering the Registry to provide the parties with a lesser redacted version of the application forms of victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10;¹

NOTING that Mr Assingambi Zarambaud is the legal representative of victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10 (the “Victims”);²

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the annexes are filed with the status “Confidential, *ex parte only* available to the Defence, the Office of the Prosecutor and the Legal Representative of the victims”, in order to be consistent with previous filings;³

CONSIDERING that on 13 March 2012 the Chamber provided the Registry with a hard copy of the Victims’ applications highlighting the redactions to be lifted and that the Registry has prepared a newly redacted version of these applications in accordance with the Chamber’s instructions;⁴

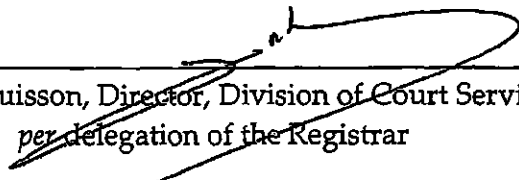
