The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (The "Court");

NOTING the Order issued by Trial Chamber III (the "Chamber") dated 6 March 2012, ordering the Registry to provide the parties with a lesser redacted version of the application forms of victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10 (the "Concerned Applications");¹

NOTING the Registry's filing of 14 March 2012, in which it is stated that Mr Assingambi Zarambaud is the legal representative of victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10;²

NOTING the Chamber's order conveyed by email, clarifying that victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10 shall continue to be represented by Ms Douzima even if they are dual status victims and therefore would otherwise be represented by Mr Zarambaud, pursuant to the Chamber's decision on common legal representation;³

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute and rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

INFORMS the Parties and Participants that Ms Marie-Edith Douzima Lawson continues to represent victims a/0866/10 and a/1317/10 and gives access to the lesser redacted versions of the Concerned Applications to Ms Douzima.
