applications for participation in the proceedings that have been identified by the Registry in the process of data entry;

NOTING the order of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 6 March 2012, that upon completion of the data entry process, the Registry submits a filing containing a table with any instances of duplicate applications to participate in the proceedings previously transmitted to the Chamber, Parties and Legal Representatives of applicants;²⁷

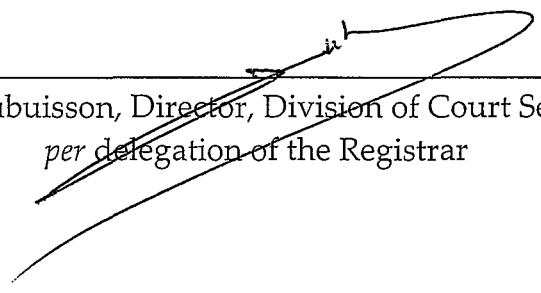
NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute and rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that due to the large number of applications for participation in the proceedings being received from the field and processed within short delays of time, no automatic check for duplicate applications by the Registry was possible prior to the filing of applications;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has now completed the data entry process of all applications received and has identified instances of duplicate applications previously transmitted to the Chamber, Parties and Legal Representatives of applicants;
