NOTING the Registry’s twenty-third transmission of applications for participation in the proceedings to the Chamber¹ and the parties and legal representatives of the applicants² dated 6 March 2012 (the “23rd Transmission”), which included application a/0487/11 (the “Application”);³

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23 *bis*, 24 *bis* and 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that one non-redacted annex is filed with the status “Confidential, *EX PARTE* only available to the Registry” and one redacted annex is filed with the status “Confidential, *EX PARTE* only available to the Defence, the Office of the Prosecutor and the Legal Representative of the Applicant” in order to sufficiently protect the identity of the applicant and the intermediary and according to the Chamber’s orders;

CONSIDERING that because of unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the applicant and of the Registry, the identity document provided by applicant a/0487/11 could not be appended to the Application at the time of the filing of the 23rd Transmission;

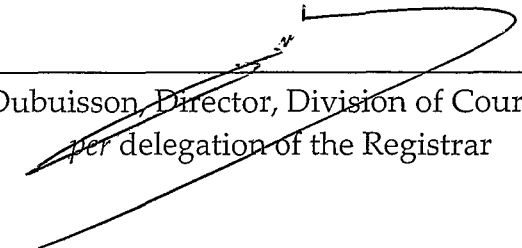
