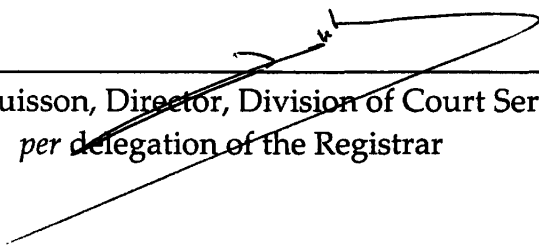
The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the "Court");

NOTING the Scheduling order (the "Order") issued by Trial Chamber I (the "Chamber") filed on 14 March 2012, ordering the Registry to file the original and public redacted versions of two reports on missions conducted in 2010 and 2011 (the "Reports")¹ by the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the "VPRS"), by 16.00 on 5 April 2012;²

NOTING regulations 23*bis* and 24*bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that an original version of the Reports is filed with the status "Confidential, *ex parte* only available to the Registry", since the Reports contain information which could lead to the identification of the persons met, and these persons had expressed strong concerns regarding the disclosure of their identities due to security concerns, both during the said Registry missions and when consulted on the matter subsequent to the Chamber's Order;

TRANSMITS the original version and a public redacted version of the Reports, as instructed by the Chamber.
