The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (The “Court”);

NOTING the Order issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”) on 9 March 2012 (“Decision of 9 March”), ordering the Registry to provide the parties with a lesser redacted version of application a/1369/11;¹

NOTING that applicant a/1369/11 was granted participating status by the Chamber in its Decision of 9 March and has also appeared as witness before the Court;

NOTING that Mr Assingambi Zarambaud has been designated by the Chamber as common legal representative of current and future dual status victims;²

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the annex is filed with the status “Confidential, *ex parte* only available to the Defence, the Office of the Prosecutor and the Legal Representative of the victim”, in order to be consistent with previous filings;³

CONSIDERING that on 19 March 2012 the Chamber provided the Registry with a hard copy of application a/1369/11 highlighting the redactions to be lifted;⁴

CONSIDERING that the Registry has prepared a newly redacted version of application a/1369/11 in accordance with the Chamber’s instructions;

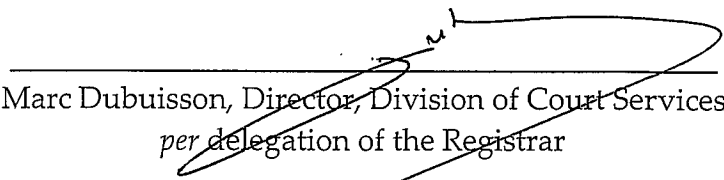
